Stephen Theriault presented numerous movies to be shown as a double feature for Black and White Movie Night, which is scheduled for Thursday, October 29. It was suggested to start the double feature at 6 PM with the intermission being filled with cartoons from the era. Stephen has enlisted SGA to serve popcorn. Josh Webster, Jinho Jung and Stephen will provide introductions to the movie. Sally Rampe raised her concerns about having children at an Abbott and Costello movie based on conversation that it may not be politically correct. Much discussion ensued and Stephen left with the committee to make a recommendation on the movies to be shown. The committee agreed on showing And Then There were None. Stephen provided the link for the committee to review the Africa Screams. The committee needs to let Stephen know what movies to show as he will also get the fliers done, etc.

Sally Rampe discussed the art show, *Flowers: Watercolors Inspired by the Colors of Summer*, which is currently hanging in the gallery showcasing Patty Fox's artwork. The artwork will be on display from September 1 to November 20. *Trails to Remember*, a collection of contemporary paintings and drawings featuring Micqaela Jones, along with special guests Myles Crouch and Shawn Collins will be displayed from October 5th through November 15th, with the reception being held October 8th from 3:00 PM to 5:00PM. November 30th through December 11th the *Student Art Show: Talents Discovered* will be featured. From January 18th, 2016 through March 11, 2016 *A Brushwork Roundup: Western Paintings and Drawings* by Craig Shepphard will be showcased with the opening reception being held January 21st, 2016 from 4:00-6:00 PM. Sally is looking for any leads on artists who may be interested in showing their art in the gallery.

Anita Anacabe-Franzoia with Rotary has asked Deepa Willingham, a humanitarian and motivational speaker to speak at the College during November 19 or 20. Anita was looking for guidance as to use of theatre and possibly working with various instructors and community groups to have high numbers in attendance at this event. Angie de Braga agreed to look into booking of the theatre during those dates. Angie invited Anita to come to the next ACE meeting to discuss more about the event.

Justine Stout is ready to work on another night of TED Talks. The committee suggested a date in September would be better rather than towards the end of the semester. The dates being considered are September 23 or 30th. Justine asked the committee to send her any ideas for talks.

Toni Milano is now spearheading the Argentum publication. Toni had a flier prepared as the goal is to seek submissions much earlier than had been done previously. There is a section for special recognition for the artists who submit something with the theme, Design for the Human Spirit, the theme being

used for the Virtual Humanities Center. Toni thanked Frank Sawyer for his help of the revision of the submission form for the Argentum website.

Justine Stout gave an update about The Film Festival Committee. Russ Minter is looking for possibly a co-chair and there next meeting will be held in October. The Film Festival will still show movies during two weekends in the month of February.

Angie mentioned Jeanne Bailey was attending an Arts Northwest Booking Conference and she will keep us posted as to if ACE receives any grant money to possibly have one of their performers come to Elko
