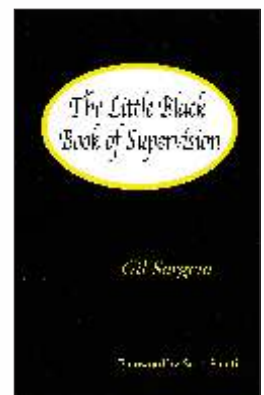
Guest Speaker, Gil Sargent
