If a General Education subject is not listed here, you may select any general education course approved for the associate degree program.

Courses marked with an asterisk (*) are critical prerequisite or bachelor's program progression courses that will impact a student's progress to completing the bachelor's degree in a timely manner if they are not taken during the associate degree program.
