The C&A committee is requesting that a Special Meeting per the Faculty Senate Bylaws be held April 3, 2019 via an email vote of the faculty senate container voting representatives. This single purpose meeting will be to conduct the final approval of the new Bachelor of Science Comprehensive Medical Imaging with Emphasis in Diagnostic Medical Sonography

This program is time sensitive as it needs to have additional approvals at Council of Presidents on April 10 and then will directly move onto Academic Affairs Council and then final Board of Regents approval.

A grant was submitted for this program last spring and the funding was not awarded until late fall with contingencies of a start date of Spring 2019 due to equipment purchased with grant proceeds. The program is currently running as a post associate certificate but has been on the master plan since 2017 with a start date Fall 2019 as a BS degree.

C&A appreciates the Faculty Senate consideration of assisting this program meet the deadlines with the email vote because it is in the best interest of Great Basin College to do so.
