



## USB Security key


- It is recommended to use a primary computer for setup
- If you are adding an MFA (multi-factor) as a new user and don't have any other method for your initial MFA, please request a Temporary Access Pass from the Helpdesk at 775-327-2170
- A Yubico Security key will be required <https://www.yubico.com/products/>

From Myapps Apps dashboard, click on **Set up MFA...**


Select **Security info** and **+Add sign-in method**




From drop down, select **Security key**, then **Add**




## Select **USB device**




Click **Ok**





Click **Ok**




Create a **PIN**, confirm and select **ok**




Touch **gold** contact on USB security key with finger




Confirm and touch **gold** contact on USB security key with finger once more




Pass key saved, click **ok**
