

Heather Steel Tech Prep Coordinator heathers@gwmail.gbcnv.edu Tech Prep allows Juniors and Seniors to earn up to 21 college credits FREE for select career and technical education (CTE) courses that they take in high school.

Students must take a predetermined sequence of CTE courses, earn an A or B, apply to be a GBC student, and fill out the Tech Prep Application to receive credit.

The Tech Prep courses available for credit are dependant on the high school that the student is attending. For a complete list of which high school CTE classes apply by school district, visit www.gbcnv.edu/techprep and click on the specific school district.

Tech Prep credits can save students time and money. Tech Prep credits are FREE, so if a student completes one Tech Prep class in high school, it will save the student almost \$200 in tuition. In addition, some Tech Prep courses count as introductory courses for GBC programs, so students may not have to take the introductory courses their freshman (college) year.

Some of the CTE classes available for Tech Prep credit are, Accounting, Agriculture, Early Childhood Education, and Welding. For a complete list, see facing page.

New Application Process for GBC CTE and MTC programs

Diesel, Welding, Electrical Systems, Instrumentation and Industrial Millwright **Programs Amp Up Requirements for Program Entry**

There is now and application process for the GBC CTE programs in Diesel Technology, Welding Technology, Industrial Millwright Technology, Electrical Systems Technology and Instrumentation. Students who are interested in these programs must now apply. Students must submit the application, three letters of recommendation, resume, letter of intent, and high school transcripts. In addition, the students will have to complete the application process for general GBC admission and complete either their SAT, ACT, or Accu-

placer placement tests. The Career and Technical **Education Department will** admit a limited number of students to the CTE Department area disciplines (diesel, welding, millwright, electrical, and instrumentation) each year. Admission is on a competitive basis. When there are more qualified applicants than there are available spaces in the programs, preference will be given to those with the highest qualifications.

Students that complete the GBC CTE application are then eligible to apply for the MTC

(Maintenance Training Cooperative) scholarship. The MTC Scholarship is a \$5,000 scholarship sponsored by local industry business partners. In most cases, the scholarship includes a summer and weekend internship. Students who wish to apply for the MTC scholarship must complete the GBC CTE application process.
