Great Basin College Scholarship Program

Each semester Great Basin College has a number of scholarships available to award in all program areas. Scholarship award amounts vary. Financial need for need-based scholarships must be evidenced through the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) process.

Disbursement of Scholarship Funds

Most scholarship awards are disbursed in two equal payments upon fall and spring semester enrollment.

Scholarship Standards

It is the student's responsibility to meet the required scholarship standards in order to maintain eligibility for the award. Academic Standards require minimum half-time (6 credits) enrollment with a cumulative 2.00 GPA unless otherwise specified.

Attendance Definitions

Full-time: 12 or more credit hours per semester

• Three-quarter (3/4) time: 9 to 11 credit hours per

semester • Part-time: 6 to 8 credit hours per semester



Re-Entry Student Definitions

At least 25 years of age • Returning to school after an 18-month or longer break or starting college for the first time.

Application Criteria

Application forms are available through the Office of Student Financial Services in Berg Hall • An official transcript or copies of an official transcript with a school seal will be accepted (high school, GBC, or transfer) • A brief statement of the student's academic, career, and personal goals must accompany each application.

Submit the completed application to Student Financial Services by March 14, 2025.
