2. PUBLIC COMMENT**INFORMATION**

Vice President Griffith- Thanked Julie and Veronica for helping with looking for someone for the Senator Position in Ely.


Pat Anderson- Updated everyone that the Athletics Task Force is ready to make a presentation to the Board of Regents in their upcoming special meeting in November 2018.
