#### INFORMATION

Student Advocate Garcia mentioned the following:

- A total of 8 people applied for open SGA positions. However, a few people never replied to Student Advocate Garcia and two online senator candidates dropped out at the last minute. This leaves 2 Vice President candidates still in the running.
- For the Fall 2021 election, she will be relying heavily on current SGA officers to recruit new members.
- SGA does meet in the summer, and officers do get paid. There will probably not be a meeting in June, but there will be one in July and a couple meetings in August before the new semester begins. The official dates will be announced before the end of the spring semester.
- The final SGA meeting for the spring semester will be May 14<sup>th</sup>.
- It is very important that officers attend the meetings to make quorum. If an officer cannot attend, they must let President Dempsey know and provide the reason for their absence. Examples of excused absences are doctor's visits, tests, practicum, family emergency, etc.
- Registration opened on April 12<sup>th</sup>. Officers who are planning on taking classes in the summer or fall should register soon.
- Officers should contact Student Advocate Garcia to let her know whether they plan to re-run for SGA in the fall.

Senator Sanchez let Student Advocate Garcia know that he is hoping to run as an Elko senator. He will email a reminder to Student Advocate Garcia.
