10. FY 2023 BUDGET

FOR POSSIBLE ACTION

Sonja Sibert discussed the 2023 Budget for SGA and its projections. There is an anticipation of 58,000\$ being rolled over from the 2022 year into the 2023 year. Fees will be increasing which will increase revenue for SGA. There was an actual revenue of about 70,000\$ in registration fees. A major part of the budget goes to the SGA officers scholarships. With the fee increases this means the scholarship will increase as well. There was a slow enrollment due to COVID and other concerns. Fall is expected to see a rise in enrollment.

Vice President Sanchez motioned to approve the FY 2023 budget. Secretary MacGregor seconded.
